

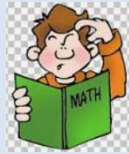
WILLOW CLASS HOMEWORK GRID FOR TERM 1 AND 2

Choose one task a week so that by the end of term, you should have completed all the tasks. Share them by emailing work to the class teachers or by taking photos to bring in to school.

<u>Active Listeners</u> Interview grandparents or an older relative or friend about toys they played with when they were younger. What toys did they play with? What materials were they made from? Tell us what they said or write some of their answers down.	<u>Shops!</u> Set up your own toy shop at home! Give some of your toys price tags. Take turns to be the shop keeper and customer.	<u>Draw your toys</u> Create a picture of your favourite toy using pastels, paint, colouring pencils, pens or even collage. 	<u>Make your own model</u> Design and build a 3D model Can you include a moving part? <u>Create a toy</u> Invent your own toy. Draw or write about it, can you write its name?	<u>Counting toys</u> Ask a grown up to give you some toys. Count how many you have. Can you put out another group of toys so you have one more and then one less?	<u>Character design</u> Draw a character from a book you have enjoyed.	<u>Board games</u> Play a board game with a member of your family. What did you like about playing it?	<u>Donate some of your toys</u> Have a look through all your toys. Are there any you haven't played with for a very long time? Can you swap with with a friend or take them to a charity shop?
<u>Old and new</u> Choose an old toy and a new toy and talk about the similarities/ differences between them	<u>Kim's game</u> To play the game arrange 5-10 objects/toys on a tray, look at a collection of objects and cover them up. An adult will then secretly take one away. Uncover them, can you work out which is missing?	<u>Make your own puzzle</u> Draw or paint a picture, then cut it up into 10 - 20 pieces. You have made your own puzzle! Bring it in for a friend to try. 	<u>Make your own toy</u> Bonnie made Forky out of different materials? What toy could you make? 	<u>Research</u> Research/google one of your favourite toys. Find out when was it made? Who made it? Why was it made?
