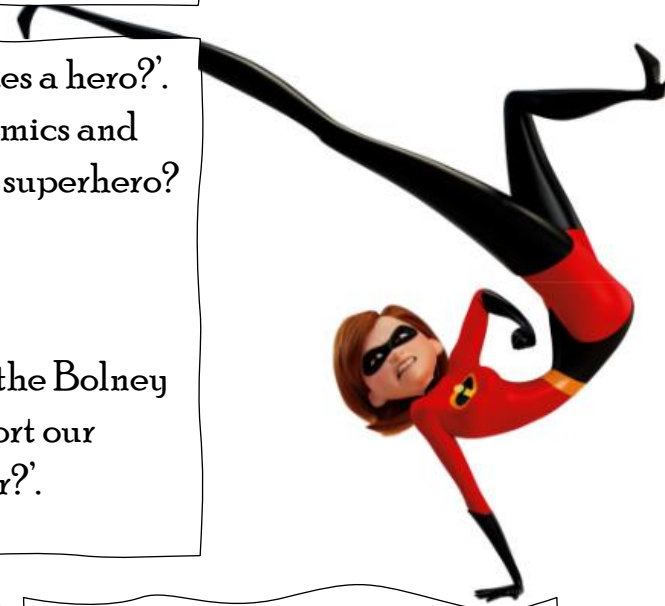


# What makes a hero?



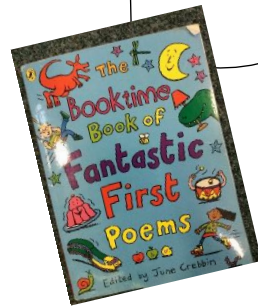
This half term Beech class will be exploring the question 'What makes a hero?'.

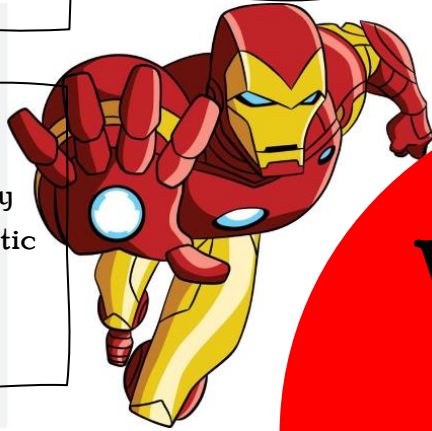
