

Bolney CE Primary School Data Analysis 2024 - 25

Pupil Outcomes

Early Years Foundation Stage

14 children: 5 girls and 9 boys, including 2 SEND, 1 Pupil Premium. *This is in line with last year.*

Year 1 phonics screening check

14 children: 7 girls and 7 boys, including 1 SEND, 0 Pupil Premium.

12/14 passed the check (86%) *which was much higher than last year (56%) and the year before (50%).*

Year 2 phonics screening check retake

7 children: 5 boys and 2 girls, including 4 SEND, 1 SEND needs, 0 Pupil Premium.

6/7 passed the check (86%) *This is higher than last year (67%).*

End of KS1 outcomes (Year 2)

16 children: 9 boys and 7 girls, including 3 SEND and 1 SEND needs.

These results are in line with last year.

Year 4 Multiplication Check

In a cohort of 5, only 3 accessed the check. 2/3 scored 22/25 (66%). *This percentage is broadly in line with last year.*
